Zambia has five large power stations, of which four are hydroelectric and one is thermal. A fifth hydroelectric power plant is under construction at Itezhi-Tezhi Dam (120MW) along with a coal

A series of pivotal agreements were signed between ZESCO, Zambia's state-owned power utility, and Power China, aimed at addressing the country's ongoing energy crisis, which has been Zambia

Located in the Choma District near ZESCO's Muzuma substation in the Chifwepa/Gamela area, the Cooma Solar plant is Zambia's first grid

While Zambia is highly dependent on hydroelectricity, some diversity has emerged with thermal and solar power plants beginning to contribute to the
